B. Desjardins declared R. Tooke Vice Chair of the Solid Waste Advisory Committee.

R. Smith provided an overview of the Solid Waste Advisory Committee Motion of November 6, 2020 regarding waste reduction targets and noted the following motion was made:

That staff be directed to continue work on updating the Solid Waste Management Plan and that staff be directed to report back as soon as reasonably practical after the approval of the Solid Waste Management Plan on measures that can be taken to achieve more aggressive waste reduction targets.

9. Solid Waste Management Plan – Consultation (verbal update)

R. Smith provided an update on the consultation for the Solid Waste Management Plan. Since the first round of consultation, a draft Solid Waste Management Plan has been developed. The second round of consultation runs from November 2020 to February 15, 2021 and includes a virtual town hall meeting with Gregor Craigie (https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=RVwP5QCe1Ww&t=107s), presentations to municipalities and First Nations and site tours. In addition to, there have been several road access conversations with neighbouring communities (Highlands, Prospect Lake and Willis Point).

The consolidated Solid Waste Management Plan consultation report will come back to the Solid Waste Advisory Committee prior to being forwarded to Environmental Services Committee.
