Activity Centre Toilet

We received a quote from Galiano Septic/Excavating on the vault toilet. Here is what the costs now look like:

Wishbone - handicapped toilet building - 12,935 plus taxes

Transport - 1,500

Vault and installation - 9,000 plus taxes

Building erection - 1,500

We are now looking at least \$25,000. Our preliminary capital estimate was \$22,000. I would recommend a contingency increase of \$6,000 to a final project budget of \$28,000. Stephen Rybak Commissioner
