SUBJECT Victoria General Hospital High Acuity Unit - Approval of a Capital Bylaw

ISSUE SUMMARY

Approval of a Capital Regional Hospital District (CRHD) \$1,019,155 Capital Expenditure and Borrowing Bylaw is required for Island Health to proceed with the \$3,397,183 Victoria General Hospital (VGH) High Acuity Unit (HAU) capital project.

BACKGROUND

Development of a HAU at VGH is required to increase critical care capacity and improve patient outcomes. As there is no vacant space at VGH, renovation of existing space is required. The project scope has an emphasis on minimum renovations to meet clinical requirements, building codes and regulations. The project will include six high acuity beds including overhead patient lifts, decentralized charting space with patient observation, care station, and a medication room. The Island Health long-term capital plan includes a future purpose-built HAU/Intensive Care Unit (ICU) project.

A Bylaw (Appendix A) authorizing the capital contribution is required in order to contribute \$1,019,155, which is 30% of the total capital budget of \$3,397,183.

ALTERNATIVES

Alternative 1

- 1) That Capital Regional Hospital District (CRHD) funding in the amount of \$1,019,155 be approved for the Victoria General Hospital High Acuity Unit;
- 2) That CRHD Bylaw No. 413, "Capital Regional Hospital District Capital Bylaw No. 185, 2022" be introduced and read a first, second, and third time; and
- 3) That CRHD Bylaw No. 413 be adopted.

Alternative 2

That the Victoria General Hospital High Acuity Unit - Approval of a Capital Bylaw report be referred back to staff for additional information.

IMPLICATIONS

Financial Implications

The VGH HAU project has been included in the CRHD capital plan for several years as a potential funding partnership between the CRHD, the Victoria Hospitals Foundation and Island Health. The project will be cost shared with the Foundation and Island Health, with Island Health being accountable for project delivery and operations. The Foundation will provide \$2,256,190 (66%) in funding, Island Health \$121,838 (4%), and CRHD \$1,019,155 (30%), for a total project cost of \$3,397,183.

On October 28, 2021, the CRHD Board approved the project as part of the 2022-2031 CRHD Ten Year Capital Plan which included the total project budget for the VGH HAU, in the amount of \$3,250,000 and CRHD share of \$975,000, timed spending in years 2022 and 2023. Since approval of the 2022-2031 CRHD Ten Year Capital Plan on October 28, 2021, the total project budget has increased by \$147,183 to a revised total project cost of \$3,397,183. The project budget increase is attributed to tenders coming in higher than estimates.

The revised project budget and CRHD share are reflected in the 2023-2032 CRHD Ten Year Capital Plan that was approved by the Board on September 21, 2022. The project costs will be cash flowed over years 2022-2023 and the CRHD share of \$1,019,155 will be debt serviced through the Municipal Finance Authority. The cost of debt servicing for the CRHD contribution has been included in the 2022 Board Approved Financial Plan and 2023 Provisional Financial Plan based on cash flow projections provided by Island Health.

In order to fulfill the CRHD's commitment to the VGH HAU project, a Capital Expenditure and Borrowing Bylaw must be approved and is presented in Appendix A.

CONCLUSION

Approval of a CRHD Capital expenditure and Borrowing Bylaw is required to proceed with the VGH HAU project. This capital project will help ensure Island Health is able to provide quality health care services for the capital region.

RECOMMENDATION

- 1) That Capital Regional Hospital District (CRHD) funding in the amount of \$1,019,155 be approved for the Victoria General Hospital High Acuity Unit;
- 2) That CRHD Bylaw No. 413, "Capital Regional Hospital District Capital Bylaw No. 185, 2022" be introduced and read a first, second, and third time; and
- 3) That CRHD Bylaw No. 413 be adopted.

The Board hereby delegates the necessary authority to the Treasurer of the Capital Regional Hospital District to settle the terms and conditions of the borrowing and to undertake such temporary borrowing as is necessary to provide funding in advance of the receipt of funds from the Municipal Finance Authority of British Columbia.
