Transportation

- Released **Regional Origin Destination Household Survey**
- Released **Salt Spring Island Active Transportation Network Plan**
- Engaged partners to support development of **Regional Transportation Service**
- Opened new **Regional Trail on Mayne Island**
- Initiated **Regional Trestle Renewal, Trails Widening and Lighting project**
- Established **Regional Transportation Service**
- Partnership and grant funding for **Reconciliation Corridor Initiative**

Housing

Climate Action & Environment

- Province approved revised **Solid Waste Management Plan**
- Board approved **Long-Term Biosolids Management Strategy**
- Implemented **policy changes and major capital works** to divert waste from **Hartland landfill**
- Established **Regional Foodlands Access Service** and **Regional Biodiversity Service**
- Progressed development of permanent facility for advanced **biosolids thermal processing**
- Opened **Renewable Natural Gas Facility** at Hartland Landfill
- Board approved revised **Climate Action Strategy**
