Shore Accesses, Viewpoints & Trails

- Orcas Viewpoint (A156 Cliffside Rd) Bench with expansive views from high cliff. Stay well back from sloping edge; grass can be slippery. **Easy**
- **2 Tafoni Viewpoint** (A218 Cliffside Rd) Bench with views of ocean and Mt Baker. **Easy**
- **3 Peacock Shore Access** (A228 Cliffside Rd) Bench with great views and sandstone shoreline. **Easy**
- **4** Pine Tree Path Shore Access (A250 Cliffside Rd) Access to CRD Regional Park, sandstone shoreline. Picnic table and bench. Whale watching. **Easy**
- **5** Shell Beach Access (A753 east end of Tumbo Channel Rd) Sandy beach, swimming, kayak launch. **Easy**
- **6** Lily Shore Access (A721 Tumbo Channel Rd) Stairs to beach. **Easy**
- **7 Tumbo Viewpoint and Shore Access** (A697 Tumbo Channel Rd) Bench with great views, sandstone shoreline access. Kayak launch. **Easy**
- **8** Strait Road (A437 East Point Rd) Bench with view of Strait of Georgia, Lower Mainland, Tumbo Island. **Easy**
- **9** West Hawk Shore Access (A399 East Point Rd) 250 m down dirt road from East Pt. Rd. Picnic table, bench, stairs to sandstone shore. Stay off rocks when wet; can be very slippery. **Easy**
- **®** Russell Beach Access (A339 East Point Rd) Loop trail to sandstone shoreline. Picnic table and bench. **Easy**

- Winter Cove Shore Access (A100 Winter Cove Rd) Views of Winter Cove, Boat Pass, Samuel Isl. Bench, stairs to beach. **Easy**
- Veruna Bay Beach Access (A103 Church Bay Rd) Sandy beach, swimming, kayak launch. Easy
- (A139 west end of Bonnybank Rd) Beach access via steep trail, steps and bridges. Seasonal cascading stream, bench with view of Lyall Harbour. **Difficult**
- 4 Sunset Beach Access (A131 west end of Sunset Blvd) Sandy beach, picnic table, kayak launch, informal unimproved boat launch.
- **Balph Shore Access** (A106 Boot Cove Rd) View of Boot Cove, picnic table, bench, access to rocky shore, swimming. **Moderate**
- Mill Road Shore Access (A104 Mill Rd) Stairs to shore, shallow tidal bay. Easy
- Quarry Trail A link-trail starting on lower Harris Rd (above vineyard) winding through woods, then east 500 m on Quarry Trail Rd, then back on trail around end of vineyard, linking up with Taylor Pt. trailhead (#37).
- **13** Waveney Road Water Acess (a trail to Lyall Creek at the north end of Waveney Rd.) Easy

CRD Parks & Other Special Places

- CRD Regional Park (end of Tumbo Channel Road via trail opposite parking area, or from Shore Access #3, see above) Sandstone shore, picnic table, bench, views, and great whale watching site. Easy
- **2)** Fog Alarm Building at East Point Restored historical building housing displays of local interest. Open summer weekends.
- **2** Lyall Creek Pocket Park (A219 East Point Rd) Small hidden gem of ferns and old cedars on salmon bearing creek. **Easy**

Thomson Park (west end of both Quarry Rd and Trueworthy Rd) Sandy swimming beach, meadow, picnic tables, benches, kayak launch, disc golf and bocce field. Large picnic shelter. (Contact Parks & Rec for large group reservations)

Gulf Islands National Park Reserve

Approximately half of Saturna is within the GINPR. Parks Canada has created many great trails that are shown here for reference. Visit their office & info kiosk at 104 Harris Rd (#30 on map) for more info and a copy of their Hiking & Camping brochure.

- **3 East Point.** Views! Trails, picnic tables, benches, beach. Whale watching!
- **Tumbo & Cabbage Islands.** Water access. Hiking, swimming, and camping.
- 3 Russell Reef. Gravel beach, reef, swimming.
- 34 Winter Cove Area. Hiking trails, great views.
- Lyall Creek Waterfall Trail. (access west end from Valley Rd, east end from Narvaez Rd). Easy except east end which is very steep.
- Mt. Warburton Pike. Incredible views! Beautiful hike along unimproved ridge trail to the east.
- Taylor Point Trail. Beautiful hike from trailhead at east end of Trueworthy Rd. to Taylor Pt. Long, difficult, unimproved trail, route finding skills required.
- 33 Narvaez Bay/Monarch Head. Trail system to beaches, walk-in camping, and viewpoints.
