MARINE NATURE PROGRAMS

These interactive beach programs help students discover connections in the environment while exploring with respect. We'll learn through games, songs and activities.

Marine programs are offered at Island View Beach & Witty's Lagoon regional parks. Most forest programs are offered at Elk/Beaver Lake, Francis/King & Witty's Lagoon regional parks. Beaver Engineever and Biodiversity Heroes are only available at Elk/Beaver Lake Regional Park.
