CAPITAL REGIONAL DISTRICT

BYLAW LAW NO. 2739

WHEREAS section 5 of B.C. Reg. 284/97 under the Capital Region Water Supply and Sooke Hills Protection Act requires the Capital Regional District to adopt before December 31, 1999, a strategic plan, including studies of water conservation and demand management, for a 20 year period respecting (a) the region's water supply, (b) water conservation, and (c) management of the catchment lands;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of the Capital Regional District in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

- 1. The Strategic Plan for Water Management, contained in Schedules A (Supply Management and Demand Management), B (Transmission System), C (Watershed Management) and D (Map Folio) attached to and forming part of this bylaw, is adopted. *
- 2. The implementation by the Capital Regional District of any and all aspects of the Strategic Plan referred to in section 1 of this bylaw is dependent on annual approval by the Capital Regional District Board of budget requirements for implementation; cooperation by participating municipalities in water conservation measures; and changes in any factors affecting the Strategic Plan, such as but not limited to, weather conditions, technological advances and population growth.
- 3. This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "Capital Regional District Water Management Strategic Plan Bylaw No. 1, 1999.
