### **Community Emergency Preparedness Fund: Evacuation Route Planning Grant - Motion of Support**

The CRD provides emergency management services in Electoral Area communities. The UBCM Evacuation Route Planning grant is a key opportunity to update and enhance emergency evacuation planning for residents and visitors to these areas. The CRD Board approved a motion to support an application to UBCM Community Emergency Preparedness Fund for the Evacuation Route Planning grant and directed staff to provide overall grant management.
