



You are in a Migratory Bird Sanctuary

THE GORGE WATERWAY AND
Portage Inlet are part of the federally
designated Victoria Harbour Migratory
Bird Sanctuary. The waterway is on
the Pacific Flyway for birds migrating
between northern breeding grounds
and southern wintering areas, making
this an important resting stop on their
long migrations.

Both resident and migratory birds depend on the fish, shellfish and other

marine species for food. The shoreline and intertidal areas provide important habitat for nesting and resting.

YOU can help the birds by:

- Keeping pets on leash
- Keeping your cats indoors
- Staying away from birds and nests
