Keith suggested that people don't know that funding is available and what it is available for. Can promote thru The Scribbler (have in the past) or word of mouth outreach. Also can do more proactively to fund and organize projects, recreation programs.

We have an employee paid an hourly wage for maintenance (Patrick). We could look into what his responsibilities/duties are and define his responsibilities a bit better. Maybe it's time to look at an increase in his wage and responsibilities (new park to look after). Should get Patrick's input as well. Add to Agenda for next month.

Also Suggest putting a phone number in Thompson Park restroom, etc so visitors can report if needs cleaning.
