MAIL BALLOT VOTING

Mail ballot voting is open to all Resident and Non-Resident Property Electors of the Salt Spring Island Electoral Area. To register to vote by mail, electors must submit a completed mail ballot application form and return to **elections@crd.bc.ca by September 30, 2026** to permit time for mailing. Applications received after this date will be available for PICK-UP ONLY and will not be mailed.

Application forms are available at www.crd.ca/vote or at the addresses listed below during regular office hours, from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm, Monday to Friday, excluding statutory holidays. To be counted, the elector is responsible for ensuring their mail ballot is received by the Chief Election Officer **no later than 4 pm on Friday, October 16, 2026** at the addresses below.

ELECTOR QUALIFICATIONS

Resident Elector – You are entitled to vote as a Resident Elector if you are 18 years or older on general voting day (October 17, 2026), are a Canadian Citizen and have resided in British Columbia for the past six months, reside within the Salt Spring Island Electoral Area, and not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or another enactment from voting. If registering on voting day, you must provide two documents proving identity and residency (one must have a signature). Please note the CRD is using the Provincial Voters List for Resident Electors.

Non-Resident Property Elector – You are entitled to vote as a Non-Resident Property Elector if you are 18 years or older on general voting day (October 17, 2026), are a Canadian Citizen, have resided in British Columbia for the past six months, have owned and held registered title to property within the Salt Spring Island Electoral Area for 30 days, and do not qualify as a Resident Elector, and not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or another enactment from voting, provided that you: a) have registered on or before August 25, 2026, or b) register at the time of voting. The following information is required at the time of registration:

- ▶ a **recent** title search, state of title certificate, or property tax notice, **showing the names of all of the registered owners**,
- ▶ two documents proving identity and residency (one must have a signature), and
- ▶ in the case of more than one owner of the property, a **completed consent form signed by the majority of the owners, designating you as the person entitled to vote for the property**. A copy of the consent form is available at: www.crd.ca/vote

Identification - The following are examples of acceptable classes of documents for proof of identity and residency (one must have a signature): BC Driver's Licence; BC ID card (BCID); BC Services Card; Social Insurance Card; Citizenship Card; Citizenship or membership cards issued by a BC First Nation governing body or Metis Nation/Federation; property tax notice; credit card or debit card issued by a savings institution; and utility bill.
