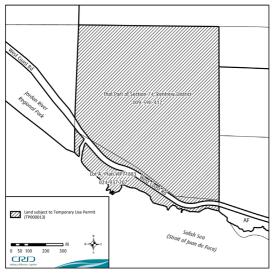
Pursuant to Section 493 of the *Local Government Act*, a local government may issue a temporary use permit by resolution in relation to land within a designated area. Temporary use permits may be issued by the Capital Regional District (CRD) throughout the Shirley – Jordan River Plan area subject to the policies of Bylaw No. 4001, "Shirley - Jordan River Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 5, 2018".
